

Official Attendance is taken at a specific time (e.g. 9:00 AM). Official attendance is NOT a period. Typically, a period is referenced because it denotes the period in which the "snapshot" falls. Once the attendance snapshot has been determined, it may not changed (save and except State **Assessment** days, final exam days, late start days due to health and safety reasons, etc.).

Excused or Unexcused? That is the question! For funding purposes, a student's absence is reported to TEA as an absence whether excused or unexcused (with the exception of any reason listed in the 2018-2019 SAAH under §3.6.3.)

Alternative Attendance Snapshot may be used in certain situations or for certain populations. To implement the alternative attendance-taking time, your local school board must have first adopted a district policy allowing for an alternative attendance-taking time, or the superintendent must have established documented procedures allowing for an alternative attendance-taking time after having been delegated authority to do so by the board, as described in §3.6.2 of the 2018-2019 SAAH (The policy may be established at any time during the school year.)
