HISTORY

George Hudson proposed the idea of daylight saving time in 1895. DST is generally not observed near the equator, where sunrise times do not vary enough to justify it. Some countries observe it only in some regions. Starting on April 30, 1916, the German Empire and its World War 1 ally Austria Hungary were the first to use DST as a way to conserve coal during wartime. Britain, most of its allies, and many European neutrals soon followed suit.
